

Terms of transportation

Based on the requirements of the aerial regulations and in order to assure safety of the passengers and the crew of the chopper, it is important to abide by the following safety rules:

- 1) Prior to entering the chopper, the passengers must undergo a safety detection check and a luggage check.
- 2) On the board of the chopper, it is forbidden to carry the following objects:
 - a. Explosives, ammunition, pyrotechnics
 - b. Weapons and toys shaped as weapons
 - c. Knives and other cutting objects
 - d. Radioactive material
 - e. Flammable, non-flammable, and poisonous gas
 - f. Magnetic material and other dangerous items
 - g. Oxidants and other organic peroxides
 - h. Corrosive substances and mercury
 - i. Poison and infectious substances
 - j. Flammable liquids
- 3) You are allowed to carry only a small amount of liquids on board. Those liquids must be packed, maximum 100ml. All of the packages must be placed in a single transparent closable bag, maximum of 1 liter per person. The following are considered liquids:
 - a. Water, beverages, soups, syrup
 - b. Lotions and body oils
 - c. Perfumes
 - d. Sprays
 - e. Gels including shampoo and shower gel
 - f. Containers under pressure including shaving foam, foam hardeners and other foam templates
 - g. Pastes (e.g. tooth paste)
 - h. Mixtures of solid and liquid materials
 - i. Other materials of similar attributes
- 4) Passengers showing signs of drunkenness or drug usage will be suspended without any compensation.
- 5) Passengers are not allowed to enter/exit the chopper if the rotors are spinning, or if the trained attendant is not there to assist them.
- 6) During the flight, mobile phones must be switched off and the passengers must be sitting safely on their seats and not disturb the pilot.
- 7) They cannot leave the chopper without the pilot's instruction under any circumstances.
- 8) During a state of emergency, the passengers must remain still at their seats and do not disturb the pilot.
- 9) One seat can carry maximum weight of 120 kg. If the passenger exceeds this limit, he or she must buy an extra seat.
- 10) Hand luggage (up to 5kg) is allowed.
- 11) When transporting the passengers' bags, the R-44 chopper can only take two passengers and two bags.
- 12) The receiver of a service must abide by the instructions and orders of the service provider. That means not entering areas surrounded by a security tape, not entering the chopper without any assistance.
